1553 Knyskanes is given the name North Cape by the English captain, R. Chancellor in his search for the sea route to China.

1594 Dutchman van Linschoten makes the first picture of the cliff, in copperplate.

1759 Prince Louis Philip comes to the North Cape when fleeing from the French revolution.

1828 Norwegian B. M. Keilhau is the first man to climb up to the plateau from Hornvika.

1845 The first tourist trip is arranged with the steamer "Prinds Gustav"

1861 German Karl Vogt starts the tradition of drinking champagne at the North Cape.

1873 King Oscar II visit's the North Cape.

1879 The mail route starts to go round the North Cape on it's way to Vadsø.

1958 Completion of the first building phase of the North Cape Hall.

1984 The Royal North Cape Club is started.

1988 The North Cape Hall – built partially inside the mountainside opened.

1997 The North Cape Hall is expanded. The new supervideograf is presented.
